Boarding/Alighting

• *Urban Areas:* Board at bus stops. To alight, push vertical strip between each window or pull cord overhead within one block of your stop.

• *Rural Areas:* Board at bus stops or flag bus by waving your hand at it. Bus stops at closest safe spot. To alight, tell driver your destination; ring bell when close.

- Stand at the stop for your desired direction of travel (inbound or outbound)
- Buses show number and name of farthest destination (ex: to downtown Harrisburg shows “Market Square”)
- Have exact fare or ticket ready before boarding, no change given

• Allow departing passengers off before you attempt to board

• Seats near the front are reserved for seniors and persons with disabilities

• Move to the back of the bus to stand

• Keep personal items clear of aisles

• Strollers and shopping carts should be moved to the back of the bus and folded

• Vulgar and profane language prohibited

• Major stops are announced on board

• Exit via the rear door where available
